

Medshield 2026 Benefit Changes

Increases and benefit changes

- Weighted average contribution increase of **7.5%**.
- Average Benefit limit increase of 4.5% on all options.

Benefit enhancements per option

- Premium Plus Medical Savings account allocation has increased form 20% to 25%.
- Premium Plus Oncology limit increased from R437 000 per family to R500 000 per beneficiary.
- Up to 5 virtual GP / Specialist consultations paid from risk according to your plan type.
- Premium Plus co-payments removed with 2 exceptions:
 - Voluntary use of non-formulary medication reduced from 25% to 20%.
 - Voluntary use of non-DSP pharmacy network reduced from 30% to 20%.
- Continuous Glucose monitoring using a small wearable device, will be funded for children under 18 with Type 1 diabetes on specific options.
- Optical benefits will be paid up to a rand amount from risk, according to your plan type.



Benefit enhancements continued

- The frequency of eye testing has been adjusted from 24 months to 12 months.
- If the member is registered on the chronic disease management programme, a repeat pathology test will be paid from risk.
- Access to the MediSaver medical savings account is now 12 months upfront; previously 6 months.
- Mental Health Benefit limits have increased for 2026 according to the plan type.
- Dischem has been added as a Designated Service Provider (DSP) for Chronic medicine.
- The frequency for Mammogram preventative screening for females over age of 30 years has been adjusted from 24 months to 12 months.
- MediPhila and MediCurve overall annual limit of R1 million for non PMB hospital cover has been removed and is now unlimited.
