

2026 New Option / Rename of Existing Option

BonCore

- \circ This is a digitally enabled hospital option that includes day-to-day funding for GP consultations.
- This plan is being launched at a monthly contribution rate of R1,275 for the main member, with each dependent also paying R1,275 per month.

Primary Select has been renamed BonPrime

- This option has transitioned from a traditional Efficiency Discounted Option (EDO) benefit structure to a New Generation Medical Savings Account option.
- The option will boast a 16% Medical Savings Account, while maintaining the existing hospital network structure.



2026 Benefit Changes

Key Benefit Enhancements:

Female Health Programme:

o Introducing an additional benefit of R1,100 for antenatal classes on Primary, BonPrime, and BonFit Options.

Synagis cover for pre-term babies

- o Synagis is a preventative treatment for serious RSV-related lung disease in pre-term infants.
- This will be covered across all options excluding BonCap.

Contraceptive Benefits

 Benefit to include the Bonitas Pharmacy Network, which will assist in the administration and dispensing of contraceptive injectables on Standard Select, BonPrime, Hospital Standard, BonEssential and BonEssential Select options.

Back and Neck Programme

o In 2026 this benefit will include shoulder and knee pain treatment on all options except BonCap option.

Hospital Network update

- o The current Bonitas Hospital Network will remain in place until the end of 2025.
- o The updated networks for 2026 will be announced October 2025 and will impact various options.



2026 Benefit Changes continue

Key Benefit Enhancements continued:

Changes to access Benefit Booster

- The previous tiered structure has been removed.
- An online mental health assessment is required to unlock the Benefit Booster as well as completing a wellness screening via the preferred partner channels.
- The Benefit Booster on Primary and BonPrime options increased by 5.3% limited to R4,000 in 2026.

Mental health consultation benefit has been adjusted

Primary: R9,780

BonSave: R15,440

o BonPrime: Paid from Savings

Chronic and Disease management

- o Benign Prostate Hyperplasia has been added as a chronic condition on BonComprehensive.
- o Diabetes insulin pump benefit will be available once every 5 years.
- o 1 Continuous glucose monitor and consumables benefit will be available annually.
- Chronic and acute medicine formularies have been adjusted per option.



2026 Benefit Changes continue

Dental and periodontal enhancements

- o BonSave: A new in-hospital benefit subjected to pre-authorisation and managed care protocols.
- BonPrime and Primary: Access to the periodontal programme to support gum health.
- BonComprehensive, BonClassic, Standard, Standard Select, BonComplete, BonSave, Bonfit: Periodontal examination now limited to once every 12 months.
- o Primary, BonPrime, BonCap: Cover for dentures removed.

Oncology and Specialised radiology realignment

- Oncology benefits will now range from PMB only cover on entry level options, to R448,200 for non-PMB cancers on BonComprehensive.
- Specialized radiology co-payment has been increased to R2,800 per scan on BonStart Plus and BonFit.

Other enhancements

- Alternatives to hospital benefits now range from R17,340 to R21,750 across all options.
- Take home medicine have been increased to R470 per hospital event on BonStart, BonStart Plus and BonFit.
