2026 Benefit changes - Kaelo MyHealth

Key Benefit Changes (Summary):

GP Authorisations: Now digital for MyHealth Vital and Core—get authorisation numbers 24/7 via WhatsApp BOT, MyHealth App, or IVR, eliminating booking delays.

GP Visits: Unlimited visits remain, but from the 4th visit onwards, clinical pre-approval by qualified nurses is required.

Benefits: Ensures appropriate care, reduces unnecessary visits, supports quicker returns to work, prevents misuse, and improves health outcomes.

Maternity Buy-Up: Covers a foetal anomaly scan (18-23 weeks) with a nurse or qualified provider at the approved rate.

Preventative Care: Core services include flu vaccinations, mammograms, PSA tests, general health checks (blood pressure, glucose, BMI), HIV testing, dental check-ups, and eye exams—helping catch health issues early and keep you healthier long-term.

Fillings & Extractions: From 2026, limited to 4 fillings and 4 extractions per person per year; no pre-authorisation needed.

Root Canal: Is not covered, except for emergency pain/sepsis treatment.

Dentures: One set (plastic/acrylic) every two years per family for those over 21, with a possible 6-month waiting period.

Kidney Stone Removal: Kidney stones may require a temporary stent. Removal of this stent requires a second procedure which falls outside the Demarcation Regulations. Kaelo have, therefore, removed this benefit.

Family & Maternity Buy-Up (100+ groups): Remains comprehensive and now includes childhood immunisations (up to 6 weeks at Dis-Chem Baby City) and contraception (R250 per quarter).
