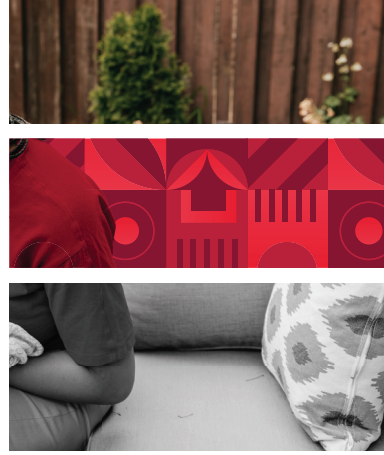

NEWBORN BABY REGISTRATION GUIDE

2026



Please take note of the following important information when registering your newborn:

01 REGISTER YOUR NEWBORN WITHIN 30 DAYS

To ensure that your newborn will be covered from their birth, without any waiting periods or underwriting, they must be registered within 30 days from the date of birth.

03 CAN I REGISTER MY NEWBORN TELEPHONICALLY?

If you are self-funding your membership (paying your contributions directly and not through your employer) you can call **0860 002 108** (for BonCap & BonCore **0861 239 333**) to register your newborn without providing documents at the time.

Please note: A copy of the birth certificate must still be submitted to the Scheme within 30 days from the birth of the newborn.

02 REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION FOR REGISTRATION

Please submit the following documents to **membermaint@bonitas.co.za** (for BonCap and BonCore **PHAMembership@bonitas.co.za**):

- Completed dependant registration form clearly stating the relationship of the newborn to the main member
- The newborn's ID number/date of birth
- Proof of identification for the newborn (e.g. birth certificate). If the birth certificate is not available, proof of birth is accepted, however, the birth certificate must be submitted as soon as possible to complete the process.

04 LATE REGISTRATION

If you fail to register your newborn within the specified timeframe (30 days), your newborn will be subject to full underwriting as per Scheme Rules.

05 GRANDCHILDREN BORN INTO THE SCHEME

If the newborn is a grandchild of the main member, they will be classified as a special dependant and be subject to full underwriting. However, if the parent of the newborn is an active member on the grandparent's membership and the newborn is born into the Scheme, no underwriting will be applied if registered within 30 days.
