- The premiums are based on members' age up to 65+ years and is determined by the age of the oldest person insured on the policy.

- It covers up to 500% for medical expense shortfall, co-payment benefit, sub-limit cover and non-DSP hospital benefit.
- It also offers casualty benefits for accidents and illness related claims.
- In and out-of-hospital benefits are subject to Overall Annual Limit.
